

ROPA Guide to Dallas

Coffee/Breakfast

- **Parterre** (go out Elm St exit from hotel, turn left and it's there) 8 - 10 AM breakfast
- **Weekend Coffee** (in the Joule Hotel, 1530 Main St) 7 AM – 3 PM
- **White Rhino Coffee** (1401 Elm St @ Field St) 7 AM -7 PM
- **Commissary** (1217 Main St @ Field St) 7 AM – 4 PM
- **Flying Horse Cafe** (in the Magnolia Hotel, 1401 Commerce St) 6:30 AM – 4 PM
- **Berkeley's Market** (2001 Ross St @ Olive St – M line trolley stop) 7 AM – 6 PM
- **Starbucks** (500 N. Akard St @San Jacinto) closes 6 PM

Lunch

- **Parterre** (see breakfast) lunch from 10 AM – 3 PM
- **Fond** (1601 Elm St, Suite 110 – go out Pacific St exit from hotel and turn right, and it's next door, down a few steps. Directly across street from Thanksgiving Square) T-F 11 AM -2 PM
- **underground food court** at Pacific and Ervay (from **Fond**, above, cross Ervay St and go underground) You'll find Mexican, Mediterranean, salads, Middle Eastern, pizza, Indian, sandwiches/wraps/burgers.
- **food trucks** at **Klyde Warren Park** (take the M line trolley to the park. Klydewarrenpark.org/food-truck-schedule for what is available on the day)
- **Jimmy John's** (1408 Elm St)
- **Chik Fil-A** (1401 Elm St)
- **Jason's Deli** (1409 Main St)
- **Commissary** (see breakfast)
- **Bread Zeppelin** (1300 Main St) 10:30 AM – 9 PM daily
- **Berkeley's Market** (see breakfast)

Dinner

- **Fond** (see lunch)
- **Gymkhana** (1408 Main St) Indian 11AM – 10 PM
- **Ravenna Italian Grille and Bar** (115 S. Field St) 11 AM – 10:30 PM
- **Campisi's** (1520 Elm, directly across from hotel) Italian 11 AM - 9 PM

Bars / Breweries

- **Statler Hotel** (1914 Commerce St) awesome rooftop bar in a mid-century modern hotel
- **Pegasus City Brewery** (1508 Commerce St) 4 – 10 PM Mon-Thurs
- **Jaquaval Brewing Co.** (also serves dinner. 312 W. 7th St in Bishop Arts, Oak Cliff – take the Dallas Streetcar from Union Station) 11 AM – 11 PM Sun-Tues / 11 AM – midnight

Wed – Sat.

- **City Tavern** sports bar (1514 Elm St, across from hotel) 11 AM – 2 AM daily
- **Scarlet Pimpernel Tavern** (1402 Main St)
- **Frankie's Sports bar** (1303 Main St) 11 AM – 2 AM

Pharmacy

- **CVS** (1411 Main St) closes at midnight; pharmacy closes at 6 PM

Grocery stores

- **Whole Foods** (2510 McKinney St – M line trolley stop) 8 AM – 9 PM
- **Berkeley's Market** (see breakfast) 7 AM – 6 PM
- **7-11 stores** (closest is Elm St @ Ervay)

US Post Office

- The old Post Office building is catty-corner from the hotel: go out the Pacific Ave door and cross Thanksgiving Square, cross DART light rail tracks, then cross Ervay St to the right (400 N. Ervay St) 8:30 AM – 5 PM Mon – Fri.

Transportation

- **Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART.org)**
- **M-Line Trolley** Mon-Thurs 7 AM – 10 PM every 17-19 min. The stop closest to the hotel will be at St. Paul St / Federal (other side of old Post Office building)
- **Dallas Streetcar** runs from Union Station to Bishop Arts District, a hopping area of restaurants, cafes, bookstores, and gift shops. Take a Red or Blue DART train to Union Station, go to front of station, then walk to your right. Streetcars leave Union Sta every 20 min at :10, :30 and :50 daily. The trip takes about 15 min and the last one returns from Bishop Arts at 11:49 PM.
- **Lime** scooters / bikes (www.li.me/about for the app)
- **In City Wheels** (3116 Commerce St) tours and rentals on bikes and scooters (www.incitywheels.com)

Parks

- **Thanksgiving Square and Chapel** (directly across from the Pacific St entrance to the hotel) The Chapel was designed by Philip Johnson and is open daily for meditation and prayer from 9AM – 4 PM

- **Klyde Warren Park** (klydewarrenpark.org) in the Arts District between Pearl St and St. Paul. Built OVER Woodall Rodgers Freeway!
- **Pacific Plaza** a block away from the hotel; go out the Pacific Ave door and turn right.
- **Main Street Garden** between Main St and Commerce, and St. Paul and Harwood.
- **Civic Garden** between Main St and Commerce at Griffin St.
- **Pioneer Plaza** at the Convention Center, on Young St between Griffin and Akard. There is a large sculpture garden of cattle being herded.

Museums and attractions

Take the M-line trolley for these 3:

- **Dallas Museum of Art** (www.dma.org) (1717 N. Harwood) Wed – Sun 11 AM – 5 PM General admission is free; special exhibits require paid tickets.
- **Crow Museum of Asian Art** (2010 Flora St) Tues – Sun 11 AM – 5 PM Spectacular small collection. Free admission.
- **Nasher Sculpture Center** (2001 Flora St) Tues – Sun 11 AM – 5 PM Admission: \$10 adult/senior \$7/educator \$5/DART ticket holder \$8

Take any color DART train to West End Station for these 4, or for the West End Historic District (restaurants and western wear):

- **Sixth Floor Museum** (Dealey Plaza) daily 10 AM – 5 PM Admission: \$27 adult/\$25 senior [JFK Memorial is 3 blocks away, behind the Old Red Courthouse]
- **Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum** (300 N. Houston St) Wed – Mon 10 AM – 5 PM Admission: \$19 adult/\$17 senior (55+) and educator
- **Museum of Illusions** (701 Ross Ave) Sun – Thurs 10 AM – 8 PM
- **Dallas World Aquarium** (1801 N. Griffin St) 8:30 AM – 5 PM daily
- **Perot Museum of Nature and Science** (2201 N. Field St) 10 AM – 5 PM daily

Take a Green line DART train to Fair Park Station (5 stations from Akard)

- **African American Museum** (3536 Grand Ave – Fair Park) Tues – Sat 11 AM – 5 PM
- **Bishop Arts District** in Oak Cliff, south of downtown. Restaurants, cafes, gift shops, bars, bookstores. See **Dallas Streetcar**, above, for directions.
- **Deep Ellum** historic area of nightclubs and restaurants on Elm, Main and Commerce Streets. Lots of murals too! Take a Green line train to Deep Ellum stop and walk over to Elm St.
